- Learn through curiosity and exploration.

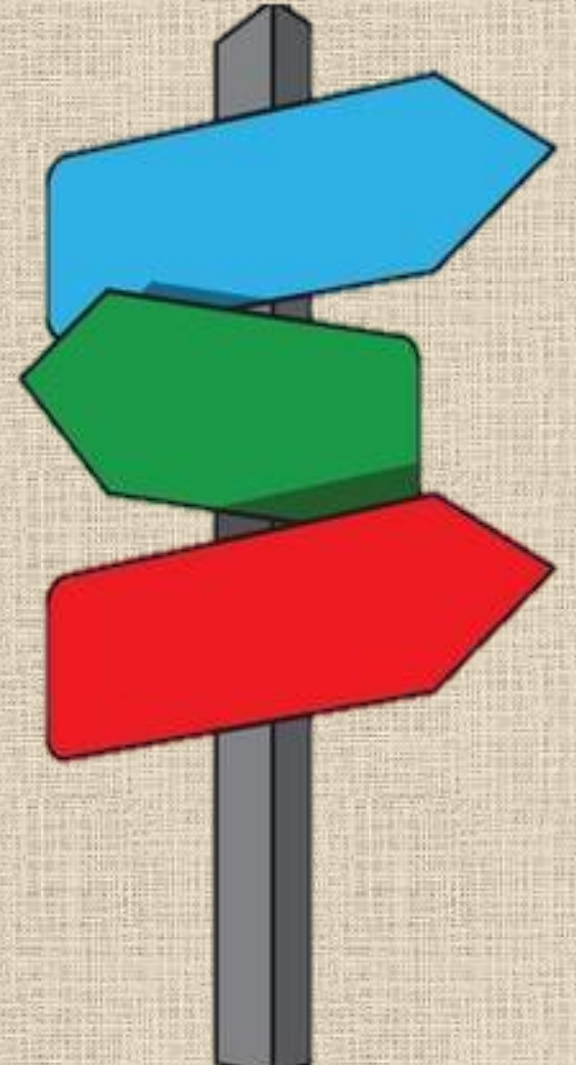
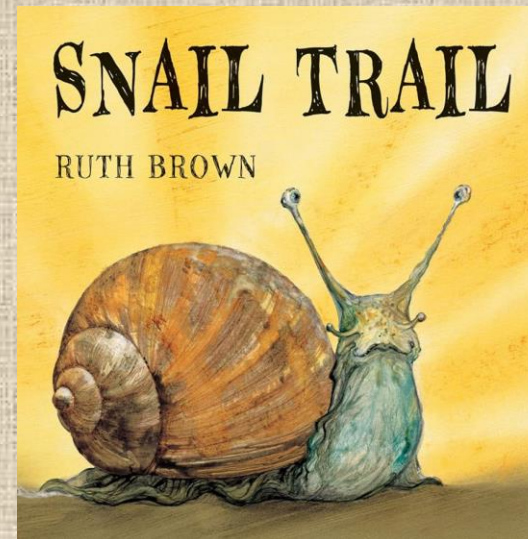
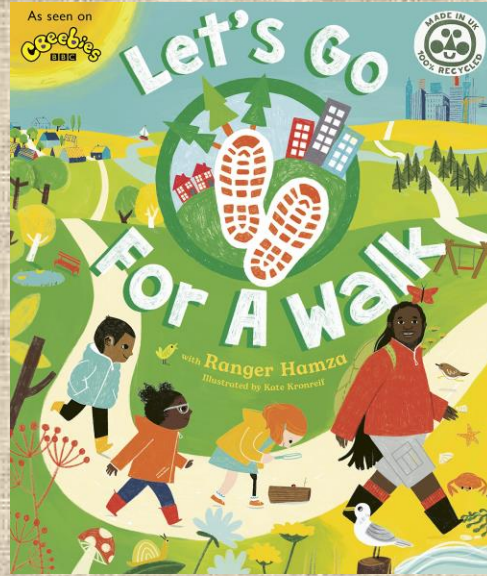

Key Writing Focuses in Year 1

- Use capital letters, word spaces and punctuation to write sentences.
- Write singular or plural words.
- Form short narratives (fiction or non-fiction).
- Join words and clauses using 'and'.
- Add suffixes to words (-ing, -ed).

Key Reading Focuses in Year 1

Word reading

- Sounding out and blending words in order to read.
- Read common exception words.
- Reading words with suffixes or contractions.
- Read books that match their phonics ability.

Word comprehension

- Become very familiar with and talk about well-known stories and key texts.
- Draw on vocabulary and knowledge to understand a text.
- Make predictions.
- Discuss word meanings.

Key Maths Focuses in Year 1

- Numbers (10, 20, 50, 100).
- Addition and Subtraction (20).
- Multiplication and Division.
- Fractions (half and quarter).
- Measurements (length and height, mass and weight, capacity and volume, time).
- 2D and 3D shapes.
- Position and Direction.
